## Tournament format & rules:

- ❑ **4-player Captain's Choice** (scramble): Men will play from the WHITE tees, seniors (60+) from the GREEN tees, & ladies from the RED tees. Prizes will be awarded to the top two (2) teams GROSS & the top two (2) teams NET. The field currently stands at 23 teams (92 players)
- ❑ **Mulligans:** Each player may purchase up to two (2) mulligans to be used anywhere on the course. Each mulligan costs \$5.00. Players must use their own mulligans – no giving them away! They will also double as your raffle tickets. Note: Mulligans cannot be used to win any on-course contests!

## On-course contests:

- ❑ **Long-drive** (#6): Drive must stay on the fairway of #6. Drives which come to rest in the rough or the 1<sup>st</sup> cut do not qualify. Make sure to mark your drive & record your name. Mulligans cannot be used to win this contest.
- ❑ **Closest-to-the-pin** (#17): Make sure to mark your shot if it's closer than the previous shot. Ball must be on the green (putting surface). Mulligans cannot be used to win this contest.
- ❑ **Hole-in-One** (all four par 3's): Prizes include a \$10,000 cash prize, full set of Callaway irons, week-long cruise, & Myrtle Beach golf getaway. All prizes are sponsored by Mike Woodworth & GENERAL DYNAMICS.
- ❑ **Hit-the-Green" wager** (#3): Specific rules will be explained on the tee. But in short, you'll have the chance to wager whether you'll hit the green with your tee-shot. The minimum wager will be \$2.00 & if you are successful, you'll be given a raffle ticket for a separate raffle to be held during the banquet. You can wager as much as you want to win additional raffle tickets, thus giving you a better chance at winning a prize at the banquet raffle drawing.

## Pre & post-tournament contests:

- ❑ **50/50 Putting contest:** To be held before play. Entry fee = \$10.00 Rules: To be explained on course. Winner receives 50% of the collected entry fees & the chance to attempt a putt worth \$2500 if made. To be held before play after the conclusion of the putting contest. The winner of the putting contest will get one (1) putt from 50 ft. No practice attempts may be made.
- ❑ **Raffle prizes:** The purchase of a "mulligan" automatically awards you a raffle ticket, so make sure you fill out a ticket when you buy your mulligans. Tickets will be drawn while everyone is out on the course playing, so once you arrive to the banquet check to see if you won something. Some of the prizes include: Complimentary foursome at Westfields – Cobra Baffler hybrid – Cleveland CG12 wedge – Titleist, Nike, TaylorMade, Srixon, Callaway, & Maxfli golf balls – CVHS golf apparel (t-shirts, hats, & visors) – gift certificates to local dining & shopping establishments. Mulligan tickets will double as raffle tickets! Each player may win only one (1) raffle prize.
- ❑ **Seven-card Poker (scratch-cards)** – Win cash prizes for a Royal Flush (\$1000), Straight Flush (\$200), & 4-of-a-kind (\$100). Cards can be purchased for \$5.00 during registration or during the banquet. Multiple cards can be purchased. The best hand will win a special prize to be presented at the tournament.
